Something to Think About

What makes you feel scared? Jesus tells us that we don't need to be afraid because God is always watching over us. God cares for us through the people who love us the most and who help us to overcome our fears and anxieties.

The Story

In today's gospel from Matthew, Jesus continues to prepare his disciples to go and spread the Good News to those who have not heard it. Jesus tells them, "Do not be afraid of anyone!" This phrase (or similar words) occurs 366 times in the Bible. Clearly, it is a message Jesus wants us to hear and observe.

The Scriptures

A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to Matthew 10:26-27, 29-30

Jesus said to his disciples:

"Don't be afraid of anyone!

Everything that is hidden will be found out, and every secret will be known.

"Whatever I say to you in the dark, you must tell in the light.

And you must announce from the housetops whatever I have whispered to you.

"Aren't two sparrows sold for only a penny?

But your Father knows when any one of them falls to the ground.

Even the hairs on your head are counted.

So don't be afraid! You are worth much more than many sparrows."

Family Discussion

As a family, talk about something you know about each other that maybe no one else knows. Jesus tells us that God knows and loves us even more than anyone in our family. How does that make you feel? Chat about who you talk to if you are worried about doing something new. Remember that we can talk to God (pray) if we feel frightened or alone.

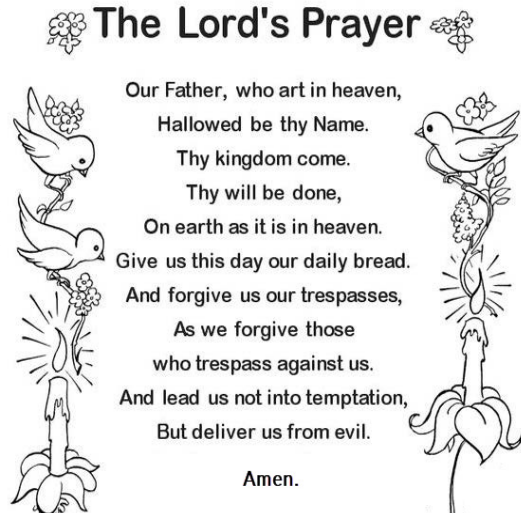
Family Activity

You will need pieces of paper for each person, pens, and a basket. Gather the family together - it could be around the table, in a circle on the floor or at a park. Each person writes or draws ways they need God's help for themselves, or for the family, or for someone else. Collect the pieces of paper in the basket. Remembering that God knows and loves us, someone takes a slip of paper from the basket, reads it to the family, and then all pray together for that need, "Loving God who knows and loves us, hear our prayer"

Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our trespasses,

Mass Bookings

With the easing of COVID restrictions, we have begun scheduling Mass for the parish. We will be following the **Industry COVID Safe Plan for Places of Worship in Queensland** which allows for an increase of people at Mass.

Attendees will be divided into groups of 20 (including children). Please ensure that there is no movement between groups. Within groups, adhere to social distancing guidelines. There will be a Marshal that will record your time in and out, and direct you to your seating area.

To ensure a fair approach and that as many parishioners as possible get to attend a Mass we ask that parishioners register for Mass weekly at the parish office on **3355 2667** or email bulletin.grovely@bne.catholic.net.au

Please register for weekend Masses by Thursday evening. To allow for contact tracing, we require your name, phone number and address. You will receive an email or phone call to advise you of the Mass you have been allocated to. (If you have already attended a Mass, priority will be given to someone who has not.)

At each Mass we ask that you sign-in, use the hand sanitiser provided, respect the social distancing guidelines, stay home if you are unwell and follow the procedures and protocols in place.
